

My First.....

REGISTRATION

Each Club shall annually register its players, officials, team mentors, (managers, selectors, trainers, coaches) on the official registration form or official electronic system. The County Registrar shall then register them with the Provincial registrar and with Central Council. Each Registration shall be accompanied by a Registration Fee, Development Fund Fee and a compulsory Injury Fund Fee as determined by Central Council.

What are Registrations?

- The registration year is from the 1st June to 31st May of the following year
- Any player registered between 1st January and 31st May shall be deemed to be registered up and including the 31st May of the following year.
- Players registered with a new club will be covered until the end of their first competitive season. i.e. registered Sept/ Oct competitive season commences the following June – covered until end of May of the following year.
- Registrations include:
 - Under 10 membership
 - Under 18 membership
 - Over 18 membership
 - Team officials, trainers, coaches, selectors, officers
- Registrations are valid when received by the Registrar of County, Provincial and Central Council accompanied by the correct fee through the online registration system.
- Registrations will only become valid on receipt of the appropriate fee.
- Any team proved to have played an unregistered player shall be fined €100 per offending player and shall forfeit the game to their opponents unless exempted by rule 238.

Exceptions to the Injury Fund Scheme are:

- Those taking part in the official schools competition
- Non playing members whose participation in the fund shall be optional
- Players taking part in the Gaelic4Mothers&Others initiative

Fees Payable to Central Council are as Follows:

Adult Players:

Registration Fee: €15.00
Injury Fund Fee: €25.00
Development Fee: €1.00

Juvenile Players:

Registration Fee: €15.00
Injury Fund Fee: €10.00
Development Fee: €1.00

Under 10 Players:

Registration Fee: €5
Injury Fund Fee: €5
Development Fund Fee: €1

Gaelic4Mothers&Others:

Club Fee: €2
County Fee: €2
Provincial Council: €2
Central Council: €6

*Development Fee shall be used for development and subsidies as approved by Central Council.
If you wish to become a full member, with full voting rights, then you need to pay the Adult fee to your club.*
