

My First.....

REGISTRATION

The Club Registrar shall submit registrations to the County, Provincial & Central Council Registrars on the official electronic system (Servasport). Each Registration shall be accompanied by a Registration Fee, Development Fund Fee and a compulsory Accident Fund Fee as determined by Central Council (Rule 49) along with County Board & Provincial Council Fees.

What are Registrations?

- The registration year is from the 1st June to 31st May of the following year (Rule 52)
- Any player registered between 1st January and 31st May shall be deemed to be registered up and including the 31st May of the following year (Rule 53)
- Players registered with a new club will be covered until the end of their first competitive season i.e. registered Sept/ Oct competitive season commences the following June – covered until end of May of the following year.
- Any team proved to have played an unregistered player shall be fined €100 per offending player under Rule 55 and shall forfeit the game to their opponents unless exempted by Rule 260.

Fees Payable to Central Council is as follows:

Adult Players:

Registration Fee: €15.00
Injury Fund Fee: €25.00
Development Fee: €1.00

Juvenile Players/U18:

Registration Fee: €15.00
Injury Fund Fee: €10.00
Development Fee: €1.00

Under 10 Players:

Registration Fee: €5.00
Injury Fund Fee: €5.00
Development Fund Fee: €1.00

Gaelic4Mothers&Others:

Club Fee: €2.00
County Fee: €2.00
Provincial Council: €2.00
Central Council: €6.00

If you wish to become a full member, with full voting rights, then you need to pay the Adult fee to your club. This applies to G4M&O only.

To Process a Registration

1. You must log into Servasport (**people.ladiesgaelic.ie**) and register your current members via the Register Members Tab or if you have a new to the club via the Add & View Members Tab.
2. Go to the Welcome screen and scroll down to Alerts
3. Then click submit registrations to County, Provincial & National etc and click on PayPal
4. You will then see a breakdown of the fees payable to each section.
5. You then make your payment via PayPal and payment will be received by all at the same time.
6. Registrations are only valid when they have been approved by the National Registrar.

If registrations are amber and you submit prior to the 31st May, then players can still play but if your registration is red, then you must wait until you have a green tick before playing.
