### Fresher Blitz 2018

1. There are 3 Cups in the 2018 Fresher Blitz, Senior, Intermediate and Junior.
2. Fresher's 7-A-Side Blitz. For the purposes of this competition Freshers are defined as students who are entering Third Level Education for the first time. Students who have been registered in another college and then transfer to year 1 of a course in a new college are not regarded as Freshers. (Third Level Education includes Universities, IT's and PLC Colleges).
3. Games are 14 minutes in length (7 minutes a half, with half time being just a quick turnaround)
4. Squads are limited to a maximum of 12 players.
5. Every player must have their college ID present on the day of competition
6. Colleges with more than 1 team are not allowed to swap players between squads. If a college does this, they shall have all of their teams disqualified from the competition.
7. All colleges have to fill out the attached registration form and present it along with the player ID cards at the sign in table for no later than 11am in DCU St Clare's Sports Grounds.
8. Colleges are to pay their registration fee of €50 on the morning and €25 for every additional team. If you are making a cheque out, please make it out to the HEC, Ladies Gaelic Football
- 9. During play, you may only score goals or fisted points only. From free kicks & penalties kicked points are allowed.**
10. A player must leave the field of play before the replacement sub can come on. Penalty for this is a penalty to the opposition.
11. In Group stages, 3 points for a win, 1 for a draw
12. If teams are level on points in the group stages, the result of their head to head game decides who is placed above the other. If the game was a draw, then the total number of goals scored in the competition decides. If still level, a 30m shoot out, best of 5, points only
13. If games are level after full time in the knock out stages, a 30m shoot out, best of 5, points only, ball cannot bounce over the bar once kicked, decides who goes through.
14. For all finals, the students individually must present their ID cards to the referee who will check it against the registration sheet.
