

Permit Insurance 2023

LGFA Players who are travelling to the U.S.A. or Canada for the summer MUST be registered club members in order to receive a Permit to allow them play on a temporary basis with clubs in these areas. As per Official Guide Rule 106, it is compulsory for all players to obtain appropriate insurance cover before a permit to the U.S.A. or Canada can be granted. Permits will not be granted after 1st July.

Accepted Insurances Only

USIT via MAPFRE (Grade 5) - Must include confirmation of an upgrade from the standard cover of "Hazardous Activities Grade 1" – to include "Hazardous Activities: Grade 5"

Blue Insurance (Grade 3) - Must include confirmation of an upgrade from the standard cover to include "Sports and Activities: Grade 3"

J1 Ireland Travel Insurance - Policy endorsed to note cover for Gaelic Games

- All players that will be seeking an Official LGFA Sanction to play in the USA or Canada for the summer are reminded that travel insurance must be arranged in Ireland **before** they commence their journeys. They must provide details of their Insurance to LGFA with their permit before approval can be granted.
- Once purchased, the confirmation letter should be submitted along with the Official Permit Form to your County Secretary who will submit it to LGFA info@lgfa.ie or post to: LGFA, Croke Park, Dublin 3.
- Permits will be approved from 31st March 2023 up to and including 1st July 2023 and once approved, all Permits will appear on LGFA website <http://ladiesgaelic.ie>
- Travel insurance is not a private health insurance. It only covers players if there is a sudden and unexpected accident or if a player becomes ill during their trip.
- It is the personal responsibility of each and every player to review the cover within their travel insurance policy in full and particularly with regards to what is covered \ not covered as regards COVID-19.
