- A group cannot contain a Provincial Runner Up and Winner from same Province

- 1. Teams play each other in group with top two in each group qualifying for Quarter-Finals.
- 2. The first team named will be designated as a 'home' venue, except where the first named team had home advantage in a previous Championship meeting of the two counties.
- 3. Fixtures to be set when all teams are confirmed.
- 4. The Quarter-Finals will involve a draw, with the 1st placed team in each group drawn against the 2nd placed teams in each group.
 - The 1st place teams will receive home advantage for the Quarter-Finals
 - 1st place teams cannot be drawn against the 2nd place team from their same group
- 5. Semi-Finals pairings will be as follows:
 - Semi-Final 1: Winner of Quarter-Final 1 v Winner of Quarter-Final 3
 - Semi-Final 2: Winner of Quarter-Final 2 v Winner of Quarter-Final 4

TG4 All Ireland Ladies Intermediate Championship – REGULATIONS

- In group stages 3pts for a win and 1pt for a draw
- No extra time in group stages
- Result on the day for any relegation playoffs
- Games against any team that gave a walkover during the group stages are disregarded in score difference
- A walkover will incur a fine of €1,500 in all grades and at all stages

Championship Regulations for Group Stages

If teams finish on equal points in the Group Stages, the final placings shall be decided by the following means and in the order specified:

(i) Where two teams only are involved, the placing will be determined as follows and in the specified order:

- a. The outcome of the head-to-head game between the two teams concerned will determine the placings.
- b. Should the head-to-head match between the two teams concerned have finished in a draw the team that finishes in the higher position will be the team that registered the highest number of points i.e. scores converted over the bar, in that head to head match.
- c. Should the teams remain equal at this point the team that finishes in the higher position will be the team with the highest score difference throughout the Championship i.e. score remaining when all scores for team throughout the Championship are added together (points will have a value of one whilst goals will have a value of three) and all scores conceded are subtracted from that number. Games against any team that gave a walkover during the Championship are disregarded in score difference.
- d. Should the teams remain equal at this point the team that finishes in the higher position will be the team with the lowest number of goals conceded throughout the Championship.

(ii) Where more than two teams are level on points the following shall apply:

a. The placing will be decided by score difference i.e. score remaining when all scores for team **throughout the Championship** are added together (points will have a value of one whilst goals will have a value of three points) and all scores conceded are subtracted from that number.

- b. Should the score difference between the three teams concerned have finished the same the team that finishes in the higher position will be the team that **registered** the highest number of points i.e. scores converted over the bar, this will determine the overall table placings; e.g. (1st, 2nd, 3rd 4th).
- c. If Teams are still level on points scored, as per point (b), then the team that finishes in the higher position will be the team **that registered the highest number of points and goals** i.e. scores converted over the bar equals 1 point, goals equals 3 points, this will determine the overall table placings; e.g. (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th).
- d. If two teams are still level after the above, their head-to-head will come into effect.
- e. Should the head-to-head match between the two teams concerned have finished in a draw, then the team that finishes in the higher position will be the team with the lowest number of goals conceded throughout the Championship.

TG4 All Ireland Ladies Intermediate Championship – RELEGATION

- After all group games are completed, the teams who finish bottom of each group, in accordance with the Championship Regulations, will participate in the relegation playoffs.
- A winner on the day for all relegation games. If teams are level after full time one period of extra time will be played followed by a 25m shoot out as per rule.
- Two teams will be relegated in 2023
- Format for the Relegation Playoffs will be as follows:
 - o Two Relegation Playoffs will take place:

Relegation Playoff 1: 3rd place Group 1 v 3rd place Group 3

Relegation Playoff 2: 4th place Group 2 v 3rd place Group 4

 The losers of Relegation Playoff 1 and Relegation Playoff 2 will be relegated to TG4 Junior Championship for 2024
