


In line with the rules of the LGFA Official Guide, the following specifications apply to jerseys and socks

- (1) The Association's logo must be displayed on all jerseys worn by players during official inter-county games.
- (2) Sleeve patches are permitted for use on all jerseys and replica jerseys
- (3) The total aera of the sponsor's brand name(s), distinctive marks or logo shall not exceed an area of 350 square centimetres as per the diagram below.
- (4) The calculation of the size does not refer to the area covered by the individual letters of a name or logo but to the total area
- (5) Sponsorship of playing attire shall be accepted, provided presentation is made to the officials of the appropriate unit of the Association and that is no obligation to wear the attire in any particular game or team photographs, and it conforms to the guidelines of Central Council.

Penalty:

Any unit of the Association which breaches the specifications or sponsorship rules shall be liable to a fine, disqualification and/or loss of expenses. Individuals in breach of the rules shall be liable to suspension.



(ii) Size of the sleeve patches are set at maximum area of 75cm2 per sleeve. That area shall be calculated by measuring the total area, including background highlighting, covered from one extremity to the other.
