LGFA Sanctions Travel Insurance Scheme

Permit Insurance 2024 LGFA Players who are travelling to the U.S.A. or Canada for the summer MUST be registered club members in order to receive a Permit to allow them play on a temporary basis with clubs in these areas. As per Official Guide Rule 106, it is compulsory for all players to obtain appropriate insurance cover before a permit to the U.S.A. or Canada can be granted.

Sanction requests will only be considered where such request is accompanied by a Certificate of (Travel) Insurance issued by our travel partner, AIG Europe S.A. – no other insurance will be accepted.

This is broad travel insurance which will cover you while playing, working and holidaying outside the Republic of Ireland or Northern Ireland for the period of the sanction/insurance.
